

**REGULATION 5.11 Standards of Performance for Existing Processes and Process Equipment Emitting Toxic Air Pollutants**

**Pursuant To:** KRS Chapter 77 Air Pollution Control

**Relates To:** KRS Chapter 77 Air Pollution Control

**Necessity and Function:** KRS 77.180 authorizes the Air Pollution Control Board to adopt and enforce all orders, rules, and regulations necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of KRS Chapter 77. This regulation provides for the control of toxic air pollutant emissions from existing processes and process equipment.

**SECTION 1 Applicability**

This regulation controls emissions of toxic air pollutants from a process or process equipment that was in existence before November 11, 1986.

**SECTION 2 Savings Clause**

An emission standard established for a Group 1 or Group 2 stationary source pursuant to this regulation for a toxic air pollutant (TAP) that is also a Category 1 or 2 toxic air contaminant (TAC) listed in Regulation 5.23 shall remain in effect until the stationary source demonstrates the environmental acceptability of that TAC emission pursuant to Regulation 5.21. Emission standards for all other TAPs established pursuant to this regulation are repealed.
